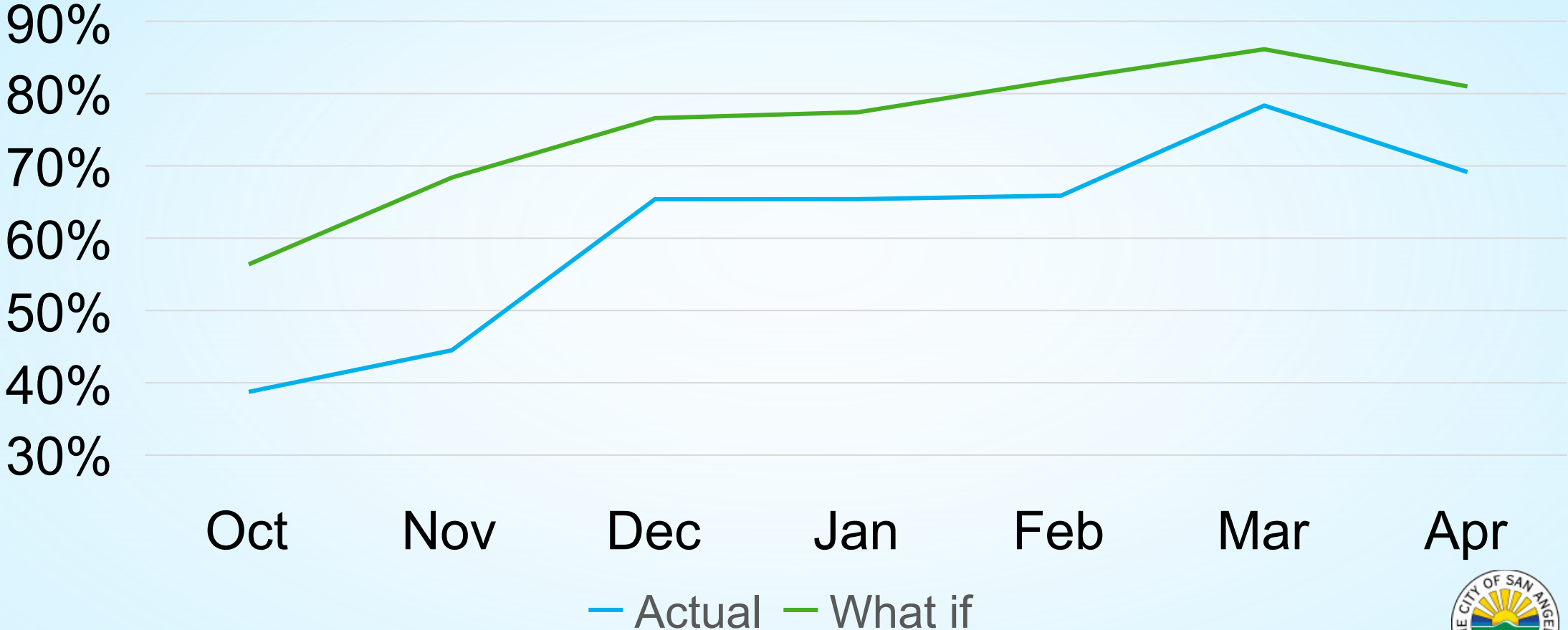
San Angelo Pets Alive!

 - Use community cat ordinance
 - Single best impact to live release rate
 - Working on funding

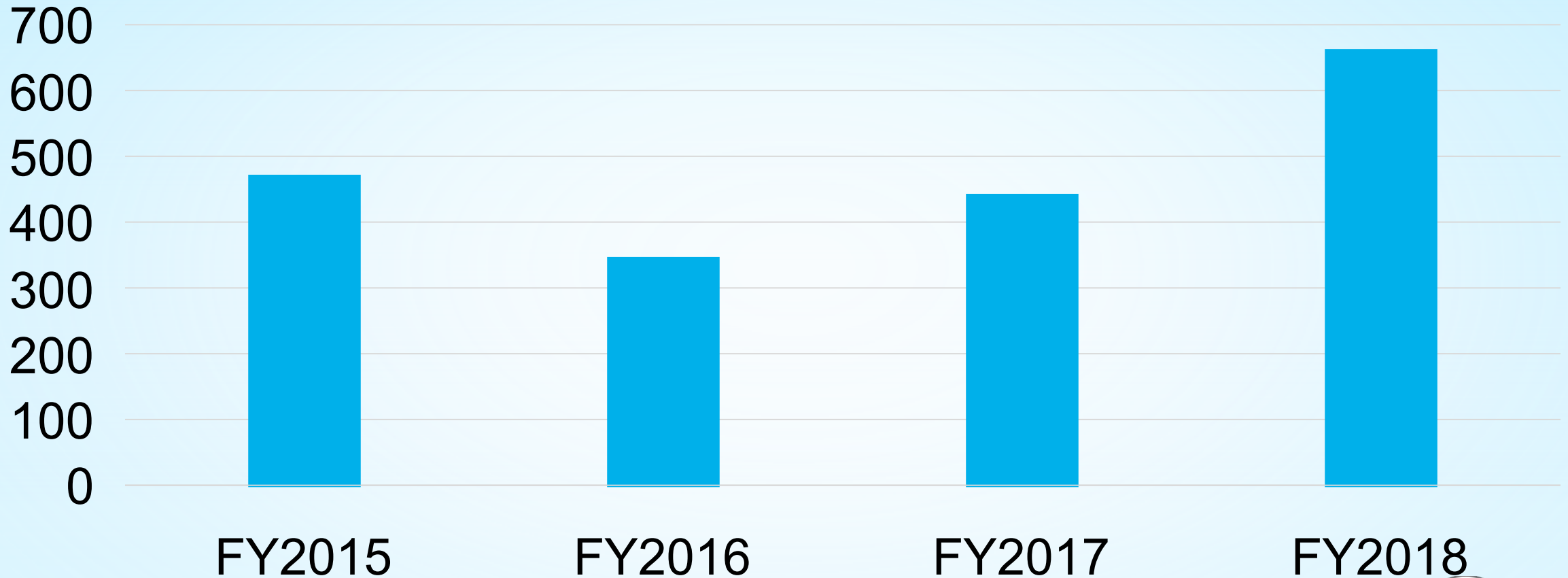
San Angelo Pets Alive!

- Appropriate capacity for large adult dogs
 - Facility improvements and expansion necessary
 - Concho Valley PAWS adoption center helpful



San Angelo Pets Alive!

- Disease prevention
 - Continue vaccinating on intake
 - Contract provides for basic & emergency medical care
 - Improved cleaning protocols
 - Multiple quarantine rooms



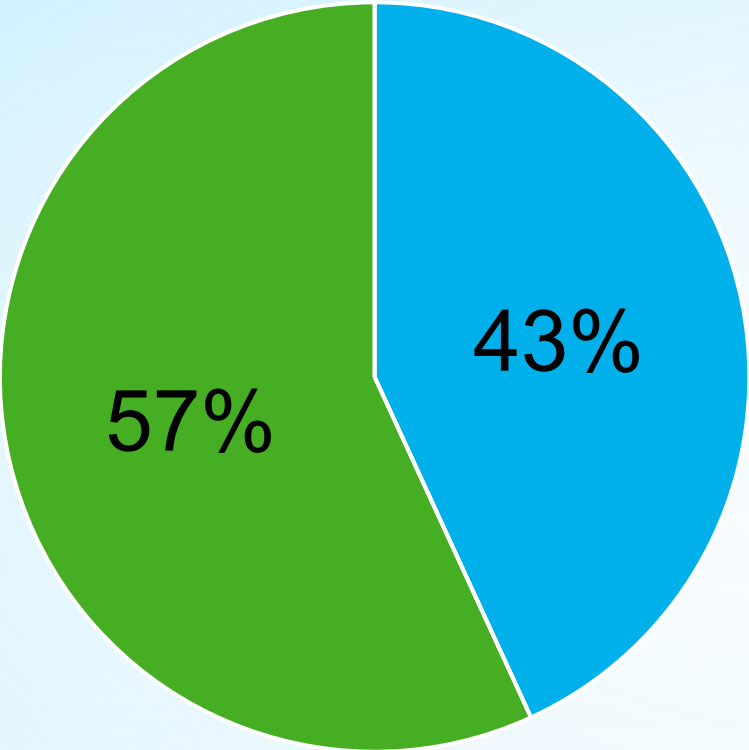
San Angelo Pets Alive!

- Intake diversion
 - For owners surrendering their pets
 - Contract provides for counseling
 - Informally launched 2018
 - Formally adopted April 2019



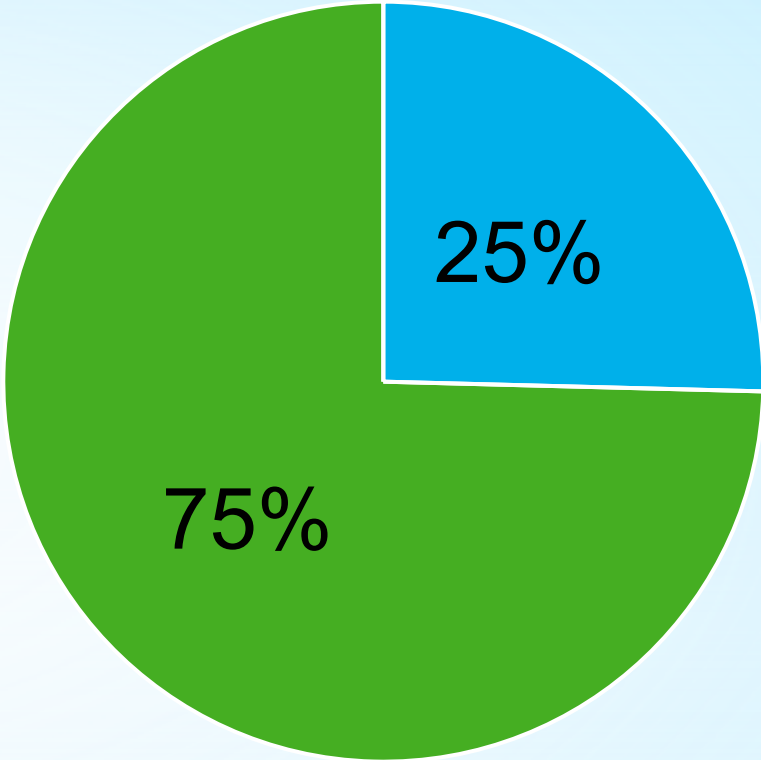
Intake diversion
